

# Watering Guidelines for Established Groundcovers\*

Drought tolerant- water deeply once a month during dry periods

Occasional- water deeply every two weeks during dry periods

Regular- water often enough to keep soil evenly moist but well drained

Moist- Soil can be constantly moist
